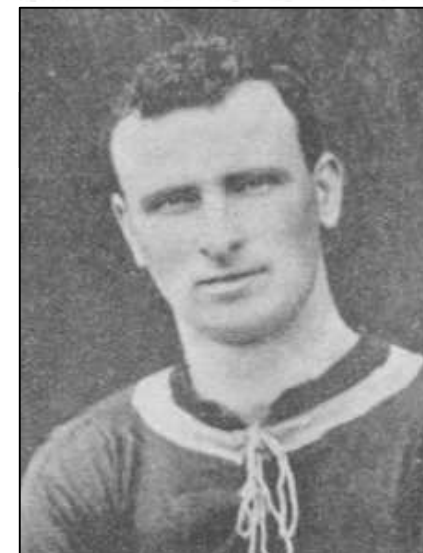

<i>Jottings</i>
Was elsewhere reported as 5ft 10in and 12st 7lb
Supposedly came South in 1907 because of ill health
A button maker by trade
His elder brother BEN was also a player at West Bromwich Albion
Played in an F.A. Cup semi-final for West Bromwich Albion in 1900-01 (0-4 v. Tottenham Hotspur at Villa Park on 8.4.1901)
Won a Football League Division 2 championship medal with West Bromwich Albion after relegation the season before
Was relegated again with West Bromwich Albion in 1903-04
The transfer fee for his move to Aston Villa was £250
Nottingham Forest were champions of Division 2 of the Football League when he was at the club in 1906-07
Appeared for Croydon Common in 3 minor cup matches, without scoring
Gained a Southern League Division 2 championship medal as Captain with Croydon Common in 1908-09
Was manager of Merthyr Town for the club's first Football League season - the inaugural season of Division 3 in 1920-21
Was manager of Merthyr Town from 4.1919 to 10.1919, again from 10.1921 to 4.1922, yet again from 4.1928 to 11.1928 and once more from 1930 to 9.1931)
Was manager of Chesterfield from 4.1922 to 8.1922, of Aberdare Athletic from 11.1927 to 4.1929 and Bangor City from 7.1935 to 1936
Was living at 21 Torre Avenue, Bristol Road South, Northfields, Birmingham at the time of his death
Upon probate in Birmingham on 7.12.1942 he left his widow Jane an estate valued at £767.8s.8d
