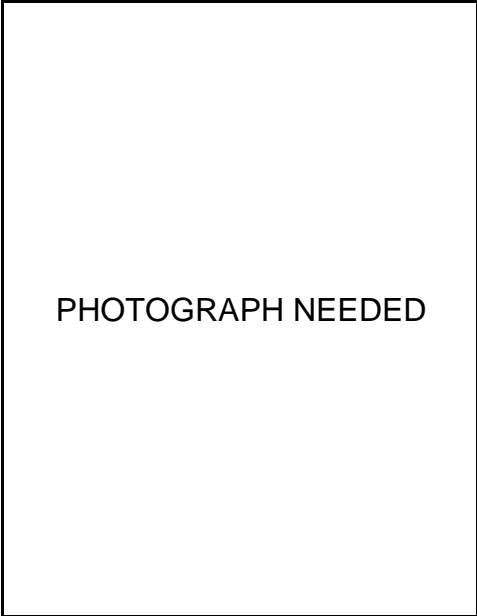

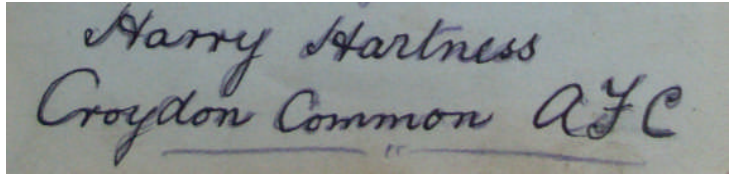

| His one appearance for Hearts was in the home 1-1 draw with Celtic on 1 April 1911, when he scored the equaliser |
| Played as a forward for Croydon Common in 1912-13, as a forward and a half back the following season, but solely as a half back for his final season |
| Appears to have returned to Benwell Adelaide for a short period during the 1913-14 season |
| Scored six of the seven goals scored by Croydon Common on the pre-season tour of Sweden in May/June 1912 |
| Was a member of Croydon Common's Southern Football Alliance championship side in 1912-13 |
| Was on occasion referred to in the press as Harkness |
| Appeared for Croydon Common in 1 minor cup match, without scoring |
