Held the record for penalty goals scored for the Common and in 1914-15 was the club's leading scorer in the league from left back
Gained Southern League Division 2 and Southern Football Alliance championship honours with Croydon Common
Was related by marriage to his full back partner at Croydon Common, Jack Little
Was known as "Monument" at Croydon Common
Played in Croydon Common's last ever match
Appeared for Croydon Common in 11 minor cup matches, scoring 1 goal, and played in at least 9 such matches for Arsenal
Was an England trialist in 1921
Served in the Royal Navy from 12.10.1906 until 16.10.1911 and claimed to be two years older when stationed at the barracks in Portsmouth
Was also recorded as 5ft 11in and was elsewhere recorded as having a fresh complexion, brown hair and blue eyes
Later managed a pub in Peckham and at one time he and his wife were a club steward and stewardess while living in Camberwell
