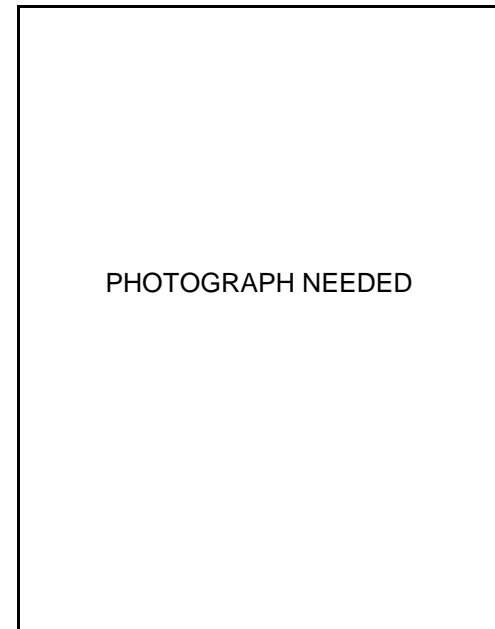

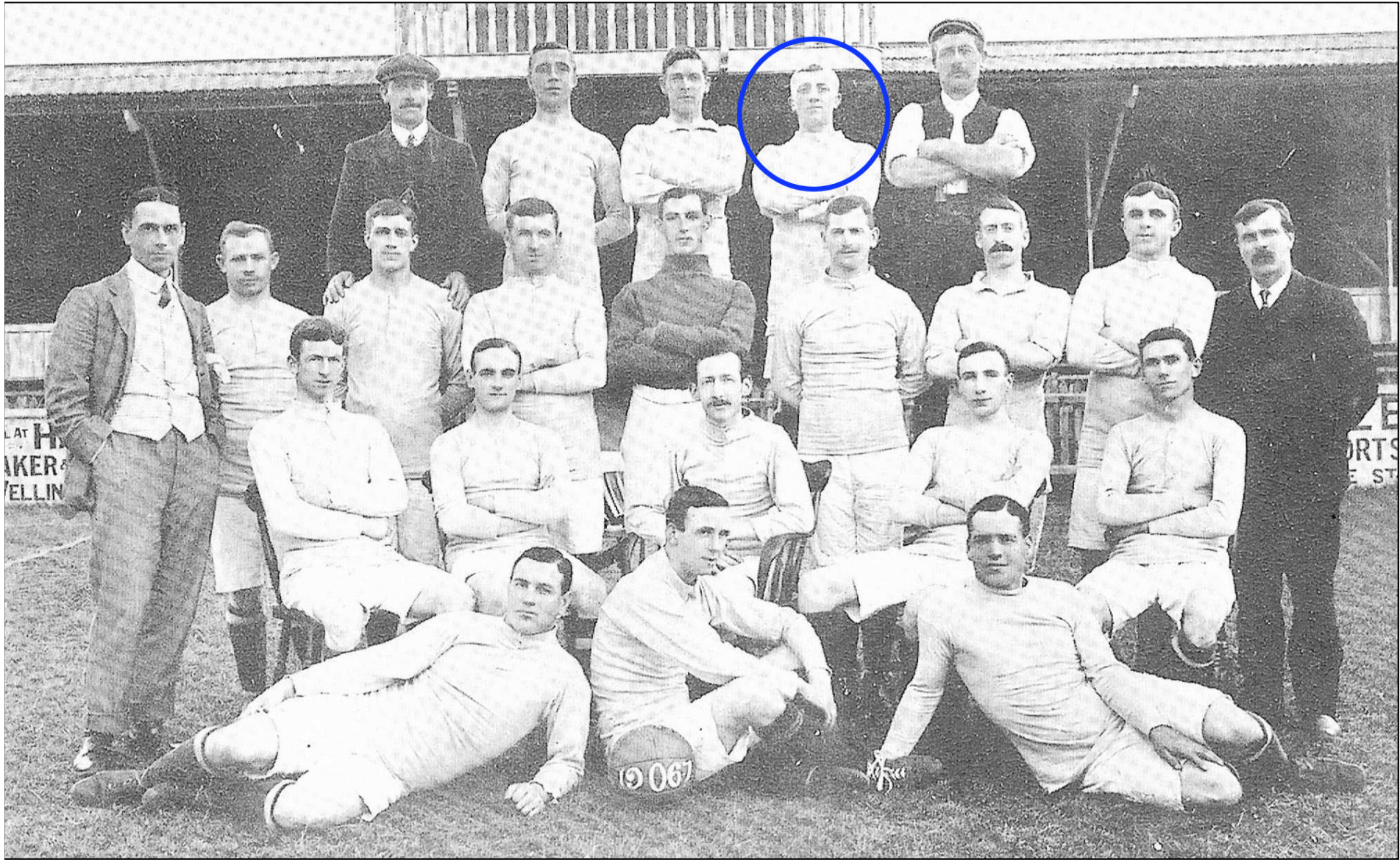

<i>Jottings</i>

Was the brother of Edwin Latheron, who played for Blackburn Rovers and England and who was killed in action in 1917
The Croydon newspapers suggested that he had been at New Brompton, but no first team appearances are recorded
The 1891 census records Robert as a scholar aged 11 years, living at 93 North Ormesby Road Middlesbrough, with his parents and his five brothers and two sisters, including Edwin, then aged 2 years
Married Beatrice Ann Kitchener on 20.5.1907
Served with the 5th. Bedfordshire Battalion and his attestation papers refer to him as having a fair complexion, light brown hair and blue eyes
When he joined up, he gave his date of birth as 3.7.1884, thus removing four years from his age
He was shot and wounded in France on 2.10.1916
Was a chemical process worker by trade
