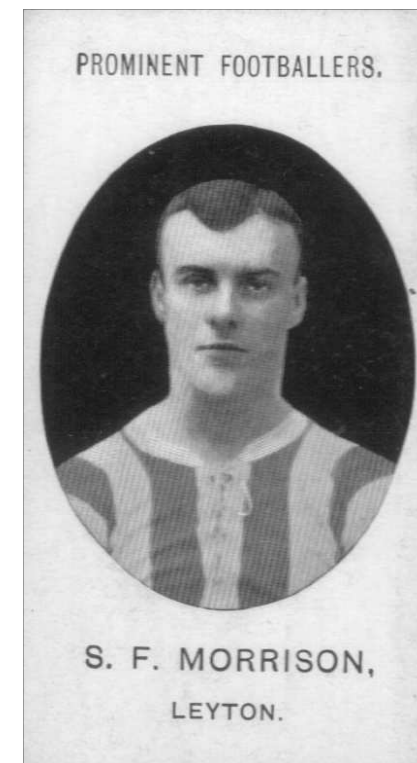

Appeared for Croydon Common in 2 minor cup matches, without scoring
He married Sarah Hannett on 22 December 1907
The 1911 Census records him as a professional footballer living at 62 Limes Road, East Croydon with his wife and son Sydney aged 2
At a meeting of the Management Committee of the Southern League on 13.8.1912, the transfer fee for his move from Leyton was reduced to £10
There is no apparent record of his birth, but he stated that he was born in 1884 in New Cross on the 1911 Census form
